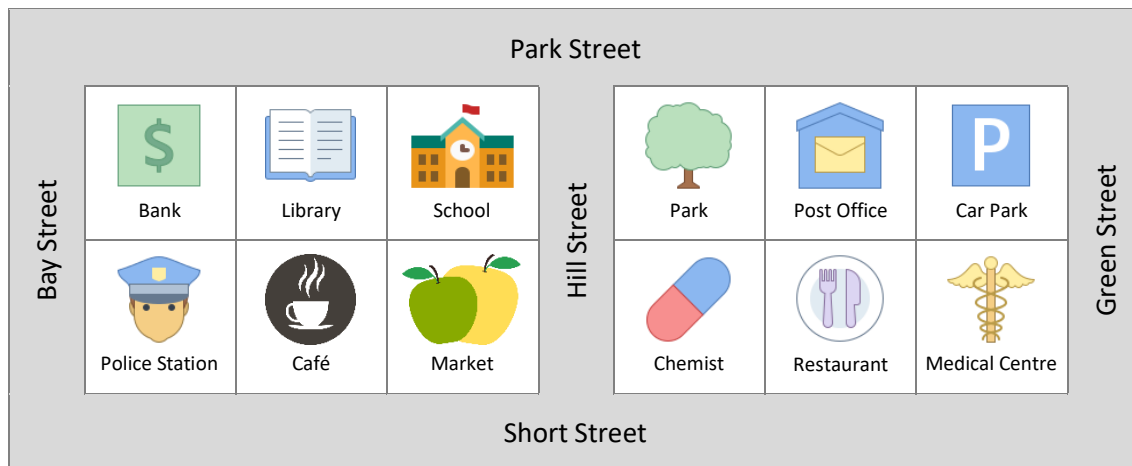

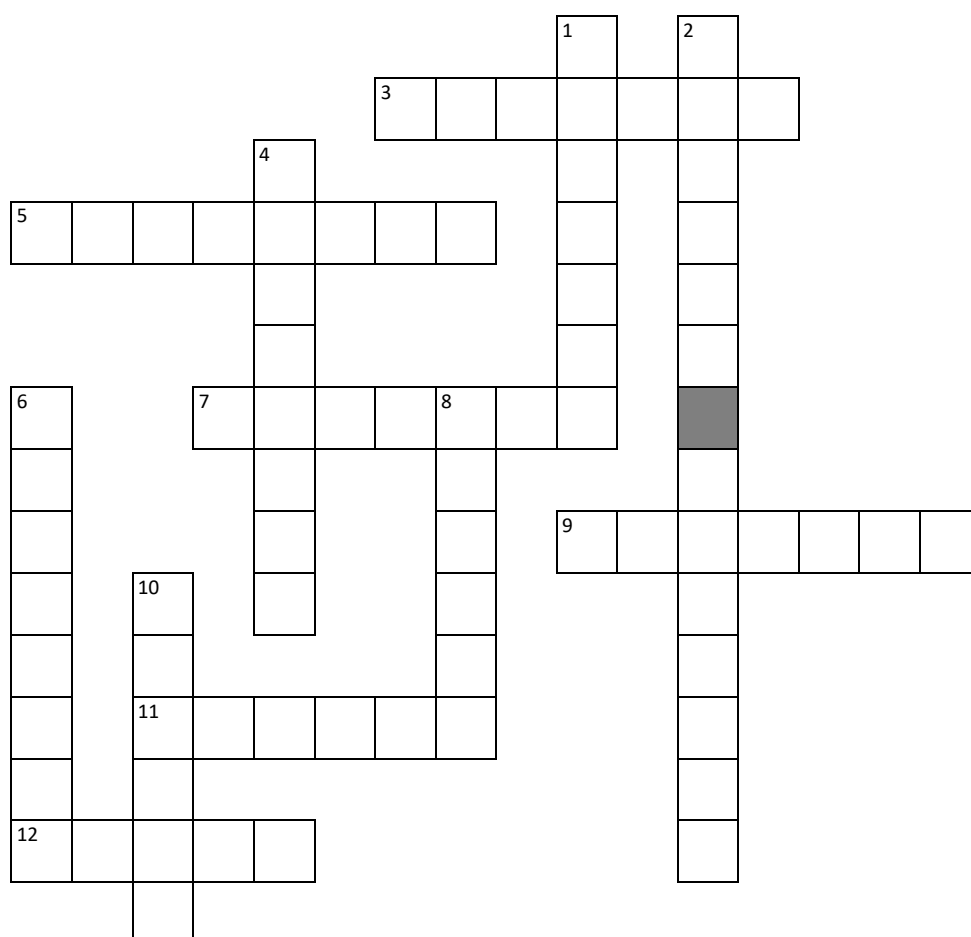

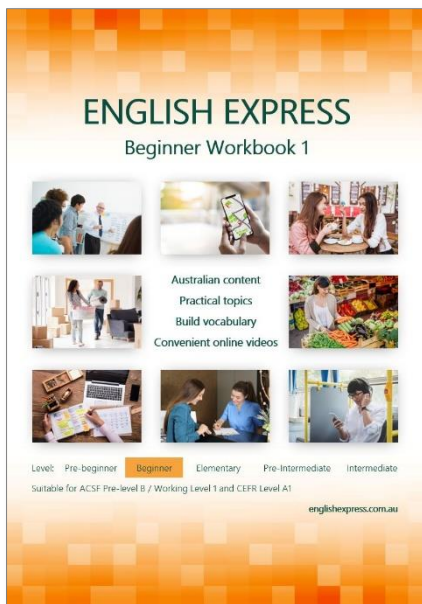

English Express Beginner Workbook 1 (eBook)

This is a PDF eBook consisting of 8 topics, plus a basic skills chapter and a review chapter. There is a strong focus on speaking, listening and vocabulary. The topics are related to everyday life, for example, shopping and house hunting. As such, the book is suited to adult learners.

The listening tasks are presented as animated videos, providing a visual context to help learners understand the meaning. Most videos are available with and without captions. The videos can be streamed online, so there's no need to mess around with CDs or complicated downloads.

The eBook is versatile and ideal for both face-to-face and online environments. You can print from it, display content on the projector or use it for an online lesson.

The eBook will be available in two versions: *Individual* and *Team*. An individual licence gives you lifetime usage of the eBook lessons with your students only. A team licence allows any teacher at one particular campus or site to use the eBook. Some standard restrictions apply to both licences (e.g. no sharing to public sites, no editing, no re-using of the images, no reselling).
